I Purpose of the Letter

1. The purpose of this Letter is the commitment of the Parties to agree on future cooperation between the Applicant and the Partner Organisation after signing an agreement on funding by The Slovak Research and Development Agency for the submitted project **under the title "Assessment of hydrogen embrittlement of steel affecting structural integrity of existing natural gas infrastructure at green hydrogen transportation"** (hereinafter referred to as the "Project").
